CEASA Meeting Notice - The ECSA Registration Process

Please note that there is a CEASA meeting on Thursday, 9 December 2004, to be held in the Orthopaedic Lecture Room at Wentworth Hospital from 12h00 to approximately 13h30.

The speaker will be Mr Tom Cooper from the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA), the body that will eventually register and license all Clinical Engineering Practitioners at various levels. Mr Cooper will be covering the practicalities of how one applies for normal Engineering Technician registration at ECSA and what happens thereafter. Time has been allowed for a questions and answers session.

Whilst the Department of Health has already instructed ECSA in writing to prepare the way for specified scope CE Practitioner registration, Technician and higher levels will still have to register first with ECSA as any normal Engineering Technician in any other discipline or industry should do anyway.

We ask employers of CE Practitioners to please release their technical staff to do attend this meeting. Interested non-members are welcome to attend.
